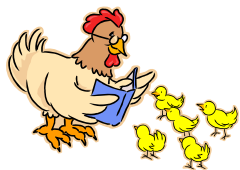

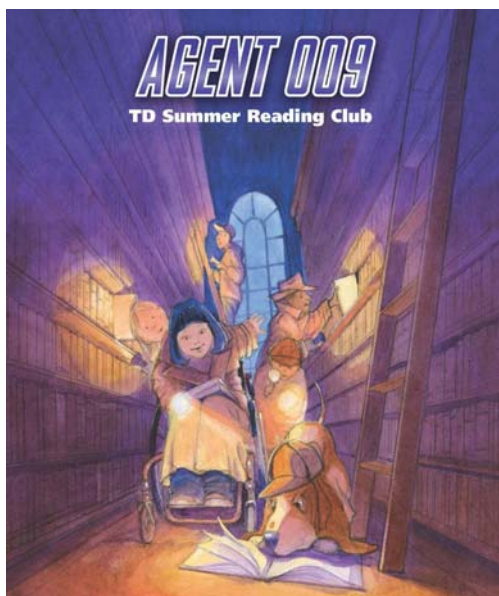


Date Change!
