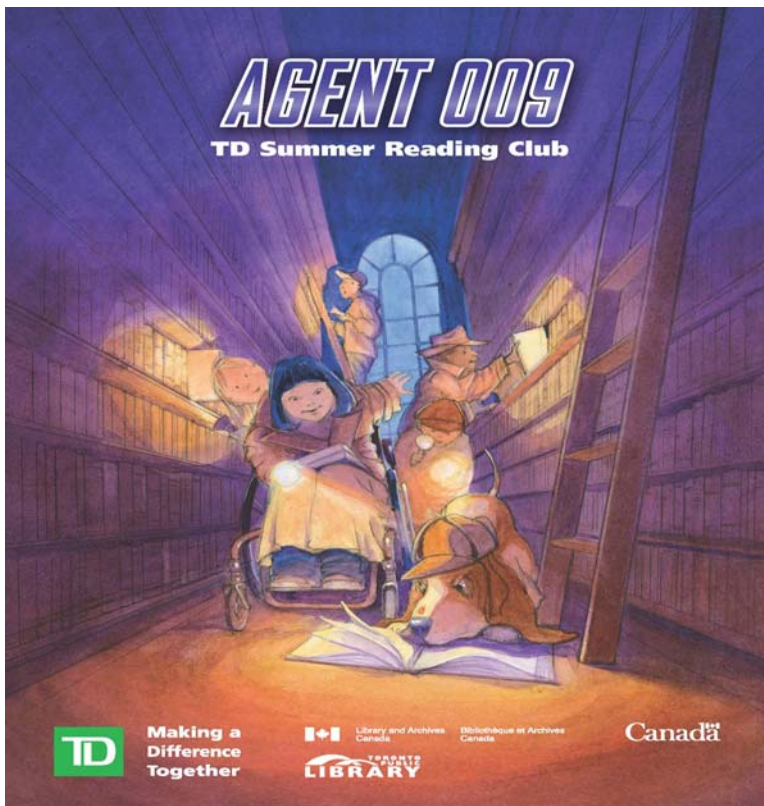
Both programs are **free** to participants.
