

What are the advantages of using an online e-resource?

E-resources are easy to use and allow you easy access to reliable information that is current and up to date. The information is always accurate and has been written by experts in the field or by writers who have conducted research to enable them to write authoritative and accurate articles. They are also convenient as there is a wealth of information, on various subjects, all contained in one spot.

E-Resource Glossary of Common Terms

Full Text - The whole article has been stored within the database, and you can retrieve it and print or email the whole article.

Bibliographic Reference - Rather than a whole article, you are provided with the title, author, magazine/journal/book title, magazine volume and page number, publisher and publishing date. If you wish to read the whole article, email an interlibrary loan request to yrlquery@yrl.ab.ca

Abstract - An abstract is a brief summary of a magazine or journal article.

Scholarly - This is articles authored by academics for a target audience that is mainly academic.

Peer Reviewed - An article is said to be peer reviewed if it goes through an official editorial process that involves review and approval by the author's peers (people who are experts in the same subject area as the author). Most scholarly publications are peer reviewed.

What is an E-Resource ?

An E-Resource is information that has been organized, categorized and then stored in an electronic filing system that can be searched using a computer. It consists of articles from numerous magazines or newspapers, journals, maps, reference books and much more.

How do I use an E-Resource ?

You must be a current member of the Library to access the E-Resources.

- Go to the Jasper Municipal Library website at www.jasperlibrary.ab.ca.
- Click on the TRAC Catalogue and E-Resources link on the homepage.
- Click on the E-Resources Link on the right
- The next screen will be a list of e-resources subdivided by various categories, ie. Business Sources, Do It Yourself, etc.

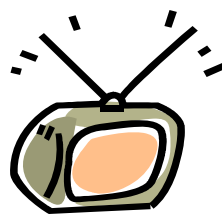
All the Resources will require you to login with

1. your library barcode number or username (unless you have changed to a username put in your barcode)
2. your PIN number or password (PIN is the last 4 digits of your phone number, unless you have chosen an alternate password)
3. Make sure to log out after you are done!

What type of information will I find?

There are many different databases to choose from. These databases contain newspaper and magazine articles, encyclopedias, health information, radio and TV transcripts, consumer reports, maps, French language materials, digitized historical documents and photos, dictionaries, almanacs, recipes, restaurant reviews and even more!



How will I know where to look for specific subjects or topics?
